The successful candidate will teach at the bachelor level in French and English. He/she benefits from a successful experience in teaching at this level.

He/she must therefore exhibit an excellent command of English (e.g. TOEFL 95 or more, with a minimum of 25 in the speaking section). Being a native English speaker is an asset. A very good command of French is also mandatory.
