EUR ELMI – 2021/2022

1. POSITION SUMMARY

The Graduate School and Research in Economics and Management (EUR ELMI) is seeking applicants for a 12-month post-doctoral position. The successful candidate must show willingness to engage into team research and a strong research agenda in line with the Graduate School research areas (<https://elmi.univ-cotedazur.eu/research/scientific-themes>). The candidate will also have to teach 20 hours related to his/her fields of expertise, in the EUR ELMI Master or PhD courses (teaching in English is possible). Teaching hours will be paid in addition to the postdoctoral fellowship at the rate of 50€ per hour.

2. ABOUT THE GRADUATE SCHOOL

The Graduate School and Research in Economics and Management (EUR ELMI) brings together faculty members and researchers from Université Côte d'Azur and SKEMA Business school, in the fields of economics, management sciences and sociology, around four research areas:

- Innovation and digital transformation
- Green Innovation and Ecological Transition
- Dynamics of organizations and territories
- Financial innovations and innovation financing system

The Graduate School and Research in Economics and Management propose to students a complete training in major contemporary economic and managerial challenges. Jobs opportunities include finance, human resources, innovative industries, strategy, management, tourism, digital technology, and economic expertise.

3. CALL SETTLEMENT

Position will start between 1st December 2021 and 31 January 2022 at the latest. The EUR will provide funding of € 2,800 net per month (€ 4,990 gross) for a period of 12 months to the person recruited.

- Applicants must have defended their PhD before the starting date of the postdoctoral fellowship (January 31, 2022, latest) in a field related to the research areas of the Graduate School (Economics, Management Sciences, Sociology).
- Applicants must have the support of a permanent scholar (mentor) from one of the research center associated to the Graduate School (see the list on the website: <https://gredeg.univ-cotedazur.fr/presentation/les-membres-du-laboratoire> and <https://www.skema.edu/research>). This mentor commits to support them throughout the duration of their postdoctoral fellowship. Applicants should contact their mentor directly to discuss and complete their application.
- Applicants must not have completed their PhD under the supervision of the proposed mentor and must not have been a PhD student or a post-doctoral researcher in one of the research centers associated to the Graduate School

4. APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

4.1. Application documents

Application materials must include (in digital format):

1. A curriculum vitae, including a list of published works.
2. A motivation letter, not exceeding one page.
3. A research proposal, not exceeding 10 pages (including references). This document must include:
 - i) The description of the research project's objectives and hypothesis.
 - ii) The description of the methodology to be used.
 - iii) A work schedule including provisional timetable and possible collaborations with EUR ELMI research faculty.
 - iv) References (1 page maximum).
4. A copy of the three main written works (published articles, thesis chapters, working papers, etc.).
5. Recommendation letter from the mentor.
6. Recommendation letter(s) from the candidate's PhD advisor and/or other scientific personalities (maximum 3)

4.2 Assessment Criteria

The main assessment criteria will be:

- The scientific excellence of the candidate's previous contributions.
- The scientific excellence and originality of the proposed research project.
- The integration of the project into the research priorities of the EUR ELMI.
- The potential socio-economic impact of the project and its trans-disciplinary aspect.

4.3 Selection process

1. Applications will be reviewed by an ad-hoc committee which composition will be decided by the Scientific and Pedagogical Orientation Committee (COSP) of the EUR
2. The selected candidates will be interviewed by the committee, which will proceed to the final ranking.
3. The final ranking will be validated by the EUR Steering Committee (COPIL).

November 15, 2021: deadline for submission of applications

From November 15: interview with the candidates and notification of the results
